### How do I know which version I am running?

Check the title bar in your Atlas Software. The title bar displays the Atlas Chiropractic Software name, the Current Logged In Atlas User, the Current Logged in Windows (Computer) User and the current Program (P) and Database (D) version number.

## What's New

- Box 22 will fill in with Frequency Code 1 when printing paper US-1500 forms
- When opening cash, users will be prompted if they want to check for preauthorized payments instead of just checking
- Atlas Flex will now load a limited number of past SOAP notes to improve loading speed of patient files
- Changes to how Manitoba Health files are named
- Added archiving of log tables
- Filter Pending button added to Insurance Billing
- Changes to image import to help prevent OLE errors

## What's Fixed


- Pitstops will now trigger properly for plans ending on max dollars
- Online tab will turn red for booking conflicts when using Atlas Hub
- Removed ability to create overlapping hours
- Statements no longer marked as sent if the email fails while sending
- Pasting into Atlas SMS messages fixed
- Changes to how deleted records are logged to allow for schedule syncing with Atlas Hub
- Changes to how hours are inactivated to allow for schedule syncing with Atlas Hub
- Adding/Modifying provider appointment types no longer adds in records for invalid provider
- Fixed the display of dates/times introduced after changes for Manitoba Health
- System ignores electronic format now when the insurance code is not 'US'
- Service and inventory groups now auto populates the individual items into the transactions grid, and sets the fees properly

- Fixed SMS error message coming up occasionally when messages sent successfully
- Changed shortcut key from F to O for Forms to not conflict with the shortcut for Find
- Tab order corrected in Providers screen and Users screen
- Disabled the Disciplines button when editing providers
- Fixed sort order on Outstanding Postdated Payments report
- Fixed insurance billing order
- Changes to how cookies are stored in Atlas Flex

## Refresh of Atlas Web

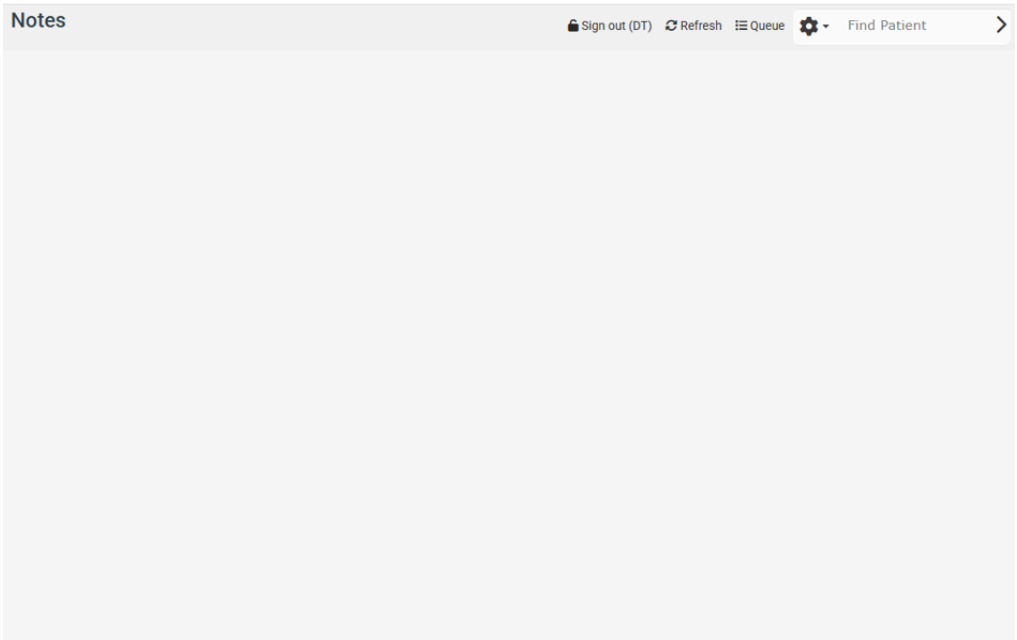
The Atlas Web program has been refreshed with a new modern look, to match Atlas Hub.

The login page:

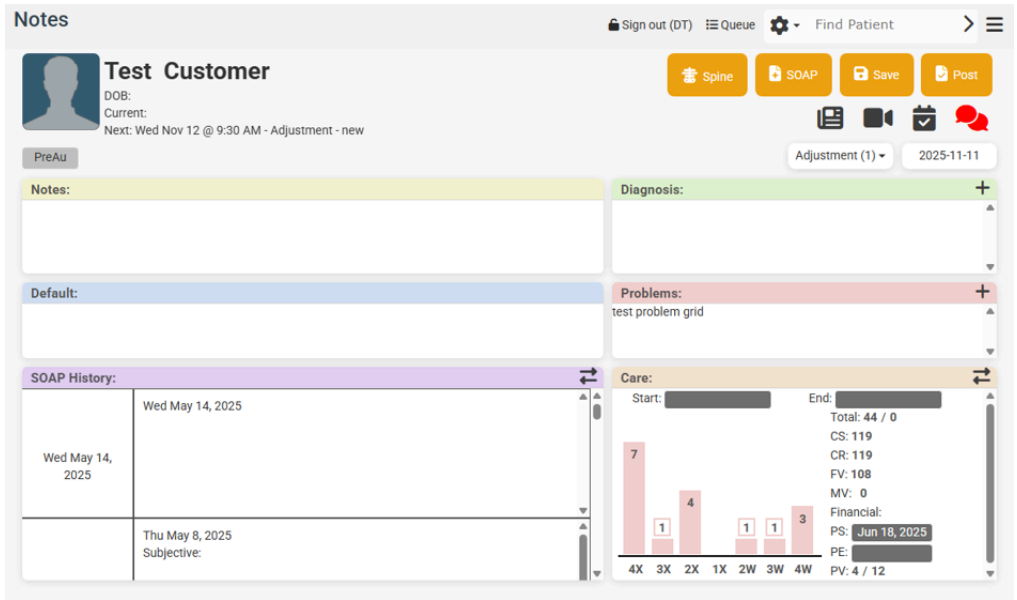
